

A life-changing medical centre opens in Voloshinka, Kazakhstan

People living in Voloshinka, Kazakhstan, had to travel over 160 kilometres to receive medical care or reach the closest pharmacy.

That has finally changed as a small medical centre opened its doors this year, where a nurse as well as a dentist assist patients coming in from neighbouring villages. The centre is located near a local farm producing grains, seeds, and specialty crops, counting among our investees since 2016.

We are glad we were able to contribute to this small, yet significant step towards facilitating locals' access to basic healthcare by financing the centre's equipment and drugs while Kazakh authorities cover human resources' costs. The centre is fully functional and has been providing medical attention to numerous patients since August 2022.
