The MPower team uses a B2B2C model to engage with local distributors to finance and distribute a range of off-grid and on-grid solar products, including panels, generators, appliances, sprayers, and pumps, for corporates, SMEs, farmers, and lower-and middle-income households in urban and rural areas.
